This incident is not an isolated case. In Paris, residents of a building in the 20th arrondissement opposed the move of a nurse, who should nevertheless be housed in an empty apartment near the Tenon hospital. The owner, who had taken care to warn the neighbors, received alarmed messages: "We do not wish to take this risk for our family and the rest of the inhabitants. He had to ask the nurse to leave, he tells France-Inter: "I called the hospital to tell them that I had two co-owners who were totally opposed to his presence in the building.
